

ISORA 2025 Data Portal Guide

The ISORA data portal can be accessed at isoradata.org on any browser. It can also be found from the [IMF's data portal](#). Use the search box to search for "ISORA".

1. ACCESSING ISORA DATA

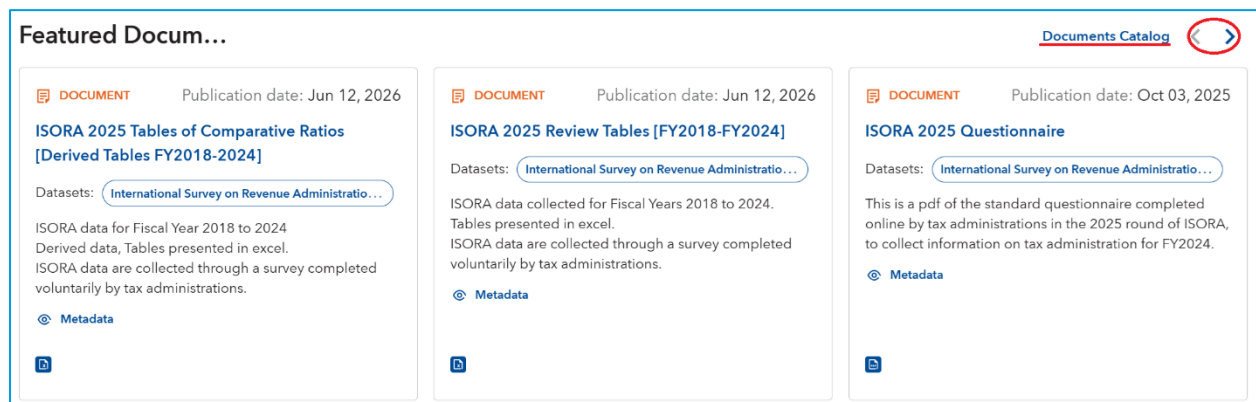
ISORA Data is available in different formats to suit the needs of various users. Users can download ISORA data as pre-formatted tables, customized tables, PowerBI tables, as well as full dataset downloads in CSV or SDMX.

1.1 REVIEW, DERIVED AND PERIODIC TABLES

Pre-formatted tables covering data for FY 2018 – 2024 can be downloaded from the 'Documents' section on the ISORA portal.

- **Review Table** - Displays data as reported by countries in the survey, with some revisions of data for earlier years
- **Derived Table (Tables of Comparative Ratios)** - Includes comparative ratios calculated using reported data
- **Periodic Table** – Includes data collected every few years regarding topics such as Institutional Arrangements, HR management, Compliance Risk management, Tax operations and Engagement with stakeholders.

These pre-formatted tables can also be found under the 'Featured Documents and Tables' section, shown in the screenshot below. More will be shown by the arrows on the top right, or by selecting 'Documents Catalog'. The ISORA Questionnaire and Guides can be found here as well.



1.2 DATA EXPLORER

Users can navigate to the Data Explorer using the 'View Data' button located in the top right. The Data Explorer is iData's tool to customize tables and select data needed. By default, the data explorer with the latest dataset will be displayed.

The Data Explorer allows users to select desired countries, indicators and time periods. All filtering can be made on the panel shown on the left-hand side.

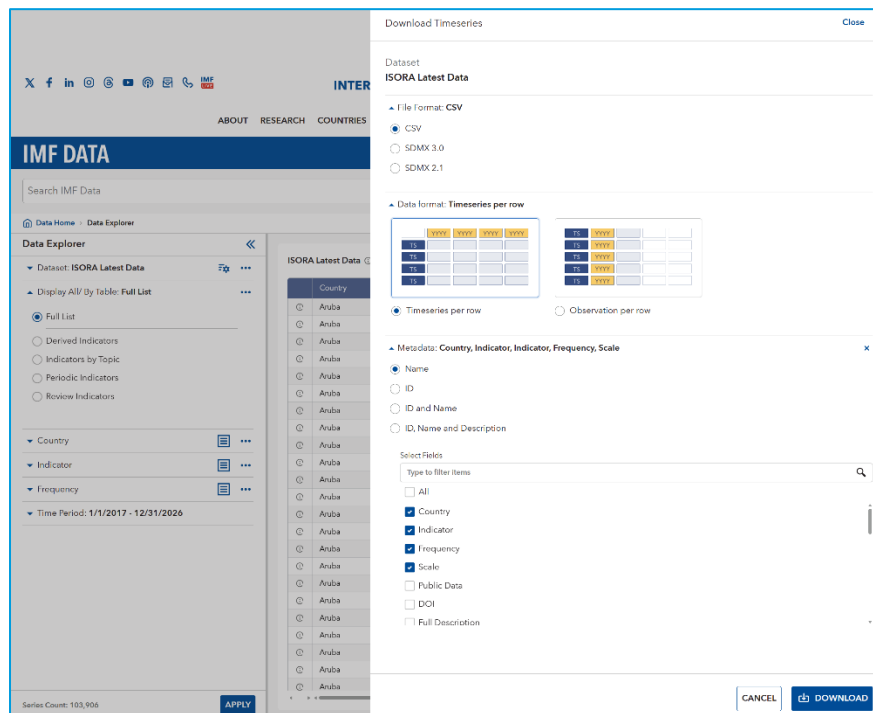

The ‘Indicators by Topic’ found under the ‘Display All/By Table’ filter is useful when you want to view all indicators for a single country. The table is shown in a pre-defined hierarchal format, grouped by topics.

Additional details can be shown by using ‘Set up Columns’ under the gear icon on the top right corner of the Data Explorer.

To Download the data, use the button shown on the top right corner. ‘Data on this page’ will download data that has been filtered by your selections, and ‘Full dataset’ will download all data available for all countries, all indicators, and all years from FY 2018. The table can be downloaded in CSV or SDMX, in your desired format.



1.3 POWERBI DASHBOARD

The PowerBi Dashboard can be used to access ISORA data by country using customized tables, and through thematic tables.

The PowerBi Dashboard is effective to

- Navigate to Latest Data and select a country to drill through to the country data tables
- Navigate directly to customized or thematic tables, and use the ‘Filters’ to select countries, tables and indicators to be displayed

2. ISORA FORMS, GUIDES AND PUBLICATIONS
